### Makaton® Beginners' Workshop

The Beginners' Workshop provides a practical introduction to the Makaton Language Programme.

Sessions include discussing commonly asked questions, hints and tips for effective signing and symbol use and how to start using Makaton in everyday situations at home or work.

You will also learn the signs and symbols for Stages 1-4 and Additional of the Core Vocabulary. Participants must have an interest in early communication skills.

**Duration:** The Beginners' Workshop is made up of 4 modules delivered over four fortnightly sessions delivered in October and November 2018.
