Commitment

The programme consists of two full day and five half-day facilitated sessions over a 10 week period. Coaching takes place in 'learning threes'; members of the 'learning threes' can come from a variety of local cluster schools.

Eligibility

This programme is open to teachers with the potential and capacity to deliver consistently outstanding lessons. Applicants need to demonstrate:

- ◆ strong commitment to Teaching and Learning and show that they are inspiring individuals with strong inter-personal skills and who are role models for students
- ◆ at least three years' teaching experience of value-added data showing student progress and improving exam results
- ◆ some external recognition (e.g. Threshold or Ofsted grades) that indicate that they have the ability to become outstanding teachers
- ◆ a commitment to professional development and the ability to truly reflect on their practice, including using student feedback to evaluate the impact of their teaching.

Impact

A recent external evaluation of this programme reports that participants become much more reflective about their teaching and are much more aware of how to make their lessons consistently outstanding. The impact of the programme is reinforced through independent assessments by schools using qualified inspectors, review teams and assessors.
